Session Actions



The Called Session meeting was held in the church sanctuary, beginning with prayer at 11:35 am. The following were present and constituted a quorum: Moderator, the Rev. Georgia King, and Elders Leah Buckland, Margaret Edgington, Phyllis Harmony, Harold Hebermehl, Pat Petty and Jerry Pool. Treasurer Pam Nicholas was also present.

The purpose of the meeting was to review the status of the roofing repair and replacement contract and its implementation. The contract, totaling some \$20,688, was negotiated and approved by the Session earlier this year. No further formal approval is needed.

Elder Pool reviewed the contract, for information only. The entire roof will be replaced, along with certain repairs to gutters and flashing. This work will begin Monday, July 30, and should be completed within two weeks (barring extensive rain days). The work will be done in sections and the grounds cleaned up as the project progresses.

The cost of the project will be covered entirely by our blanket insurance policy. Most of the funds already are in one of our church cash accounts and will cover all agreed upon progress payments.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:45 am.
