Session Actions

There was not a stated session meeting in the month of July.

The called Session Meeting took place on July 9th, 2006. It was held in the Conference Room and was opened at 11:40 a.m., with prayer by the Rev. Georgia King. The following were present and constituted a quorum: Moderator the Rev. Georgia King and Elders Margaret Edgington, H.W. Hebermehl, Hazel Howard, Julia Kasch, and Jerry Pool. June Voigt was also present.

Moderator King reviewed purposes for the meeting: (a) Set a standard meeting date for the Session, (b) finalize changes to the computer system, and (c) discuss the manse lease and possible disposition of the building.

Concerning the meeting dates, a motion was made and passed to hold a stated meeting on August 20 after worship. It is also moved and passed to fix the third Wednesday of each month for stated meetings. Beginning time would be at 5:00 p.m.

A new Dell computer system will be purchased, with installation and program transfers by Patty Kasch.

The manse lease ends on August 31. Since the current renters wish to remain in the building, the Session must formally extend the lease for some time period. Mrs. Voigt reviewed our options and recommended that the lease be extended for six months, with further extension month-to-month and with a thirty day notice of cancellation by either party.
