Session Actions



The Stated Session meeting was held in the Church Conference Room, beginning with prayer at 6:55 p.m. the following were present and constituted a quorum: Moderator, the Rev. Georgia King and Elders Leah Buckland, Margaret Edgington, Phyllis Harmony, Harold Hebermehl, and Jerry Pool. Elder Pat Petty was absent. Treasurer Pam Nicholas was also present.

A motion was made to approve minutes of the April 18, 2007 Stated Session meeting. Motion passed. A request for transfer of membership of Marge Shepherd to Community Presbyterian Church of Benson, Az. Was approved.

Under Church Maintenance, the \$6,973 amount covered costs of repair and refurbishing the new music room, which was completed last December. Other than the above noted budget deviation, income and expenses are in line. The Treasurer's report was accepted.

Concerning the long awaited roof repair, Elder Pool still does not have a written detail of the work to be done and a signed contract. The repair people are proving difficult to work with. Elder Pool has an agreement with an individual to mow the lawn for \$25 per mowing. The price is low since the person groups other lawns in the same trip. Elder Buckland will speak with him regarding the work being done (there is a language barrier to deal with). Motion by Elder Edgington and seconded by Elder Buckland to approve the agreement of \$25 per mowing with a monthly cap of \$100. Motion passed.

Rev. King will attend a leadership seminar in Amarillo latter this month. Payment will be assigned to Continuing Education. Fellowship events planned over the spring and summer months were reviewed. It appears that we did not receive Denomination materials for the Pentecost Offering. Elder Buckland will see if we have an supply of envelopes to distribute, with the idea of receiving the offering on May 27. There are several minor repair jobs to be done around the church, and we discussed means to correct them without over burdening church members. It was noted that the sodium light over the main entrance will be repaired (the original wiring was incorrect).

The Pastor's contract expires July 14, and we initiated discussing regarding continuance and review. There will be a Called Session Meeting when all elders can be present to finalize the contract renewal. Rev. King noted that we have not been starting Sunday worship promptly at 10:30. After some discussion, it was suggested that the Adult class should start promptly at 9:15 so that other activities, specifically choir warm up, can occur with adequate time prior to worship.

Duty Elder for June is Pat Petty. The next Stated Session will be June 20. the meeting was adjourned at 8:25 pm.
